P: In the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit.

P: As the hour of his death drew near, Jesus said, "Now is my soul troubled. And what shall I say? 'Father, save me from this hour'? But for this purpose I have come to this hour.'" (John 12:27) Throughout his earthly ministry, the cross stood before Jesus. It was his purpose in coming to the earth. Guided by love and in obedience to his Father's will, Jesus came to lay down his life as the atoning sacrifice for the sins of the world.

P: On the night before he died, Jesus told his disciples, "A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another." (John 13:34)


C: The cross of Jesus guides us in the way of love.

He suffered and died to take away your sins. I announce to you that your sins are forgiven in the name of the Father and of the + Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

C: Lead us, Lord Jesus, to walk in love as you did, and to reflect your love in the world.
